Eclipse Watch on the Labyrinth

Want a clear view of the upcoming eclipse? On a quiet hill with friends? Come to the labyrinth area on Monday, August 21, at 12:30pm. Bring your lawn chairs or a blanket for the lawn, a sack lunch if you wish, & solar eclipse glasses. If you do not have the glasses, a limited number have been ordered and will be available. According to the Eclipse Map via Bob Clubbs ([HTTPS://timeanddate.com/eclipse/map/2017-august-21#](https://timeanddate.com/eclipse/map/2017-august-21#)), the partial eclipse for Cape begins at 11:51:06am & ends at 2:47:33pm with maximum coverage at 1:21:11pm. (Totality duration is only 1 min. 48 sec.) It is imperative that you use certified solar eclipse glasses for eye protection! You are welcome to walk the labyrinth & come & go as you wish.
